The state leadership continues to keep abreast of developments in Springfield, communicating information through occasional Minibriefings, and also serves SUAA members through meetings with governmental leadership. The Legislative Committee article in this newsletter highlights the current situation. The fall election will be very important to the future of the State. This period shows that organizations such as SUAA are stronger when membership continues to grow and when many members are active. Be involved. Come to the spring Chapter meeting on April 25 and volunteer your time and expertise. If you have friends who are not members, bring them to the meeting and get them involved. Remember that current employees are eligible to be SUAA members. Follow through with the actions that are recommended in the Legislative Committee article.

The Chapter could not be effective without those people shown in the newsletter as Chapter leadership, people who have and continue to serve you. Several Executive Committee members are completing their terms this year: David Bechtel who has expertly organized programs for meetings, notably for the Chapter meetings; Katharine Kral who has served the Chapter as secretary and served SUAA statewide for four years as state treasurer; Carl Larson who has been involved with program planning, communications and planning for the 2008 Big Ten Retiree Association Conference; and Morgan Lynge who has efficiently made arrangements for meetings and also worked on the planning for the Big Ten Conference. Judy Rathgeber is also leaving the Committee. She has been instrumental in arranging the Survivor's Benefit Workshops and in providing leadership for the Survivor Assistance Program, including the preparation of the Benefit Guide brochure. The Chapter thanks these individuals for their service.

The Chapter is also fortunate to have an excellent slate of nominees for the Executive Committee. Be sure to read the newsletter article on these nominees, with the election being held at the spring meeting on April 25. The Executive Committee members are pleased that Edith Terwilliger has agreed to serve the remainder of Rathgeber's term. Terwilliger's appointment was approved by Executive Committee vote in accord with the Bylaws. She held a number of positions at the University, retiring as Associate Dean in the College of Education and as Executive Director of the Council on Teacher Education.

The Chapter continues to work toward increasing communication with members and recently participated in a SUAA state survey regarding statewide communications. Gary Engelgau continues to improve the Chapter website, and Heidi Rockwood serves as newsletter designer. Be sure to check the Chapter and the state websites regularly for informational updates. The Chapter sends occasional letters with information important to the members. In December, Chapter members received a letter about Chapter dues. When the State SUAA dues were increased, the Chapter Executive Committee voted to offset the state dues increase by decreasing the Chapter dues.

The Benefits and Membership Committees are also active. Elsewhere in this newsletter you will see information about the Survivor's Benefit Workshop. If you have not attended one of these successful workshops, be sure to do so. In addition, Paul Dollins is planning an April 6 regional SUAA meeting for members of SUAA Chapters in East Central Illinois. He is being assisted by Morgan Lynge and Bob Todd.

The primary mission of SUAA is to advocate for its members and their pensions and benefits, work which also affects current employees and nonmember retirees. This advocacy has been a major activity during the past year. However, you are also aware from news reports that the University is currently under financial stress, and some employees may be suffering financial hardship. There are many retirees and employees who have been financially able to contribute to the University and its departments through the years. I want to remind you of one fund that assists employees with emergency situations, the Faculty/Staff Emergency Fund (UIF/UIUC Faculty and Staff Emergency Fund). Information about this fund is available at the Faculty/Staff Assistance Program website: <http://fsap.illinois.edu>. Although the fund is not available to retirees, be aware that the services of the Program are available to both employees and retirees.

These are challenging times, as you are aware. I appreciate the communications that have been received from you and the work of my colleagues. Please fill out the form on the back of this newsletter to let the Chapter know of your interests and concerns.

The workshop session will be conducted by a SURS representative and will be one hour or greater, depending on the number of questions. This will be an interactive meeting that will allow you to ask questions and receive answers directly from SURS staff.

NOMINATIONS TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

At the spring meeting, four members are elected for three-year terms to the twelve-member Executive Committee. The four nominees selected according to Article V of the Bylaws are listed below. Additional nominees who consent to serve will be requested from the floor.

Thomas Conry retired in 2006 after serving for 35 years on the faculty of the Department of General Engineering and then the Department of Industrial and Enterprise Systems Engineering at UIUC. In addition to his teaching and research activities in mechanical design and tribology (friction, lubrication and wear of materials), he served as department head for eleven years (1987-1998), as Chair of the UIUC Senate Council in 1996-97, and was elected to the three-campus University Senates Conference for two terms from 1997-2003, serving as Chair in 2001-2002. Prior to joining UIUC, he worked for General Motors for five years, and had summer work experiences with Sargent & Lundy, Engineers, NASA Lewis Research Center, and Caterpillar. His sabbatical leaves were taken at the University of Cambridge, England and at the Caterpillar Research Center.

Tom is a Life Fellow of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME). Among his many leadership activities, he was a member of the Society's Committee on Finance and Investment from 1999-2004. This committee had the fiduciary responsibility for managing the Society's \$60-million endowment and also recommended the Society's operating budget to the ASME Board of Governors.

In retirement, Tom works part time in forensic engineering consulting with Ruhl Forensic, Inc. He served as President of the Urbana Rotary Club in 2008-2009. He is a registered Professional Engineer in Illinois, Wisconsin, Texas, and Arizona.

Stephen K. Rugg retired from the University of Illinois in 2007 after a career that began in 1971 as a graduate assistant in the UIUC College of Education. From 2002 to 2007 Rugg served as the UI's Vice President for Administration, a position which included concurrent appointments as Comptroller of the UI Board of Trustees and Treasurer of the University of Illinois Foundation. From 1976 through 2002 he held a variety of positions in the University's Office for Planning and Budgeting, including sixteen years heading the office as Associate Vice President. As Vice President Rugg also served as the state's chief procurement officer for Illinois higher education. Rugg headed the steering committee responsible for the successful implementation of comprehensive new financial, human resource and student information systems across the three UI campuses from 2001 to 2005. Prior to coming to the UI Rugg served for three years in student affairs positions at Dartmouth College, his undergraduate alma mater. He is a U. S. Army veteran.

In retirement, Steve Rugg serves as a trustee of the Urbana Parks Foundation and as chair of the board for the Champaign County Design and Conservation Foundation. He currently is a member of the Community Advisory Council for Illinois Public Media (WILL Radio and Television), a community member of the Building Committee for the University YMCA and, with his wife, Deborah, is a member of the Krannert Council at the Krannert Center for the Performing Arts.

Richard M. Schoell (Rick) retired in August of 2009 from the University of Illinois (U of I) after twenty two years of service. While at the U of I, Rick served as Executive Director for Governmental Relations from 1998 until 2009 and as Director of Federal Relations from 1987 until 2009. In addition to serving as one of eleven University officers during his time as Executive Director he also had primary responsibility for the management of the federal and state governmental relations programs for the three campuses of the University. During his career with the U of I, he served on the Council for Federal Relations of the Association of American Universities and the Council on Governmental Affairs for the National Association of State Universities and Land Grant Colleges. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the International Arid Lands Consortium and he presently serves on the Carle Foundation Community Advisory Board.

Prior to joining the University, Rick served for five years as the Director of the Illinois State legislature's Washington D.C. office. Before going to Washington he worked for three years as a research analyst for the Illinois Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation in Springfield Illinois. Rick earned his B.A. and M.A. from the University of Iowa. He was a member of the National Conference of State Legislatures Executive Committee and was a part time instructor for courses in American Government and Politics at Lincoln Land Community College.

Virginia (Ginny) Waaler retired from the University of Illinois January 1, 2009. She began working at the university in a part time position in admissions and records. In 1984, she began a career in the Executive Development Center in the College of Business, assisting the staff by preparing materials and logistics for executive conferences. Following this, in 1994, she joined a team to develop a special program for Chinese managers, directors and administrators who attended executive conferences taught by the UIUC professors and administered by the EDC. In 2000, she became the Director of the China Executive Leadership Program. In 2002, the program became a part of International Programs and Studies. During this time, the center provided over 165 executive management programs to Chinese managers on the UIUC campus. She made many trips to China to promote the University of Illinois. She received a bachelor and masters degree from the College of Education at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The huge challenges in 2009 to the Illinois five major pension systems persist and have become more acute in 2010. Last year several legislators introduced legislation in the Illinois General Assembly which would, if passed into law, dramatically change the benefits offered by current Illinois pension laws. One of those bills would have eliminated for future pension systems employees the defined benefit plans now offered and replace those with a defined contribution plan. Other bills proposed to change other plans by a reduction of benefits. One bill was introduced to consolidate the investments of the five systems to a single commission.

SUAA and other groups strongly opposed those bills and none were passed into law. However, 2010 is the second year of the Ninety-Sixth Illinois General Assembly session, and therefore those bills introduced last year could again be brought forward in this session if the leadership chooses to do so.

The major problems of a severe recession which limits state revenue and the failure of Illinois government in past years to balance expenditures with revenue has created a fiscal crisis second only to the State of California. According to some critics, the budget deficit of approximately eleven billion dollars in 2009 is now projected to be thirteen to fifteen billion.

The General Assembly year began the process of fiscal recovery by voting on a proposal to raise income taxes. The Senate passed that legislation, but the House of Representatives declined to vote for the measure. Thus the opportunity to improve and maintain the viability of those important sectors of Illinois such as education, health care, human services, public safety and others must wait at least another year for a resolution to this fiscal crisis which touches the lives of most of Illinois citizens. The Governor and Legislators again chose to "kick the can down the road". The legislative scene in Springfield in 2010 will be much like 2009. One can expect certain sectors of Illinois, such as those representing some corporate and business interests, to demand major reforms to diminish pension systems benefits as a way to reduce the budget deficit

in the years ahead rather than improving Illinois revenue by way of increased taxation.

SUAA's Executive Committee supports revenue enhancement rather than further budget reductions. Obviously, there are always ways to improve efficiency in all layers of government, but the leadership of those sectors in Illinois dependent on some or all of their income from the State of Illinois knows that without a new and improved revenue stream many services for Illinois citizens will be severely eroded or eliminated.

You can be assured SUAA with its 14,500 members will be working over the course of this year to protect public employees and retirees. This year's legislative session will pose many challenges and possibly some threats to future and current public employees and possibly retirees. As stated earlier, there are powerful groups and organizations which endeavor to reduce pension benefits, and it is important that SUAA counter those threats.

Chapter members can help in this fight. SUAA suggests all members stay abreast of the political issues and be aware of what our elected officials are doing about issues of concern to SUAA members. All members should telephone, email, write letters to and/or visit their Representatives and Senators to ensure they understand your concern. Suggest to those whom you know who are SURS members that they should join SUAA, if they are not currently a member. Finally, each member can support SUAA action financially with a modest contribution which will be utilized to protect the pensions and other benefits of current and future SURS members.

We can and must prevail with issues that affect the quality of life for so many people.

Determination, organization, unity and real action will serve us well!

REPORT ON THE FALL 2009 MEETING

The Fall meeting of the State Universities Annuity Association, Urbana-Champaign Chapter, was held Sunday, October 25, 2009 at the I Hotel & Convention Center. A social time of refreshments and conversation with friends was followed by a brief business meeting.

The program was a presentation by two of the newly elected members of the Board of Trustees of the State Universities Retirement System (SURS), J. Fred Giertz of Champaign and John Engstrom of Sycamore.

Public Act 96-0006 created a new eleven member Board of Trustees of SURS and provided for a dramatic reorganization of all the state's pension systems. The bill proceeded through the General Assembly with bipartisan support and passed the House by a vote of 116 to 1 and the Senate 57 to 1. Its passage set in motion a statewide election among SURS contributors and annuitants to elect 4 contributing members and 2 annuitant members to the new board. In addition, the Board of Trustees of SURS is comprised of 4 other Governor-appointed Trustees and the Chair, the current Chairperson of the Illinois Board of Higher Education.

We were fortunate to have a contributing member Trustee and an annuitant Trustee of the Board to address the fall meeting. Fred Giertz is a Professor of Economics and currently the Chair of the Department at UIUC. He is also a Fellow with the Institute of Government and Public Affairs and a frequent guest speaker at SUAA meetings. He was previously a member of the SURS Board. John Engstrom was elected as an annuitant Trustee to the Board. He is the retired KPMG Accountancy Professor at Northern Illinois University and lives in Sycamore. He is active in the NIU Annuity Association, serving as its treasurer.

Both gave short remarks about their impressions and assessment so far and answered questions. They relate that the SURS staff is very capable, but the state funding situation is very bad! They felt that there is a good benefit structure and those that have retired 10 - 20 years ago are keeping up with inflation. On the other hand, pension funding is problematic. Both observed that the underfunding is not so much a function of the downturn in the market as it is a result of the lack of appropriate support from the State. Indeed, the State has many other funding challenges. SURS has not been receiving monthly contributions and may not get payments this fiscal year. SURS is selling securities to meet its obligations, but they observed that the sale of stock is not nearly the problem that the State's non-payment is.

The search for the new SURS Executive Director is moving along well, after it was restarted in August. There are over 70 applicants with interviewing anticipated in December

The Trustee election process could be improved in the future. They gave compliments to the strong staff work, but felt that there was a complex political environment in which the election was held. The election was a hasty process that may have given unfair advantage to organizationally supported candidates.

They felt it was possible for the new Trustee Board to assume an advocacy role with the State legislature, but to a lesser degree with the media. Both encouraged SUAA members to contact local legislators and offer their opinions as their own advocates.

We were most impressed with the new Trustees and happy to have people with their experience and expertise representing retiree's interests.

The Membership Committee

A list of the 1,993 members who are current in their dues payments is included later in this newsletter. There are 1,376 annuitants on this list who are noted with an asterisk (*) indicating they pay their \$30.00 annual dues by having \$2.50 deducted from their monthly State Universities Retirement System (SURS) annuity payment. The remaining 617 members have paid their dues in a single \$30.00 payment. Please check your name this list to be sure we have your membership correctly shown. If you paid dues during the past twelve months, and your name is not included on the list or improperly recorded, please inform us with a note sent by email to suaa.ui@gmail.com or by mail to the address on the address page of this Newsletter.

We occasionally receive complaints from annuitants that a deduction was being taken from their monthly payment, but we were not listing them as members. In almost all cases members had approved a deduction for an organization other than the UIUC Chapter of SUAA. If you are a dues deduct member of our chapter, your SURS Statement of Benefits with your January payment should show the following deduction: U of I U-C Chapter SUAA - - \$2.50. If it says something else, you should contact SURS to find out to whom you are contributing and why.

Why is your membership important?

SUAA works to protect our retirement benefits and the financial solvency of SURS. Even though the State Constitution says that retiree pensions shall not be diminished, changes are regularly proposed that negatively affect SURS participants. Other proposals surface regularly that could affect the financial health of all of the State's retirement systems, which have been repeatedly under-funded in past years. Had the State met its financial obligations when it was supposed to (and like all of you have done), the investment returns on these funds would have put the retirement systems in a much stronger financial position today. Also, adequate health care continues to be important to all of us. SUAA tracks all of these issues and makes our concerns known to the policy-makers. As SUAA becomes more involved with these matters, it gains visibility and respect and is now being consulted

on matters affecting our benefits. SUAA also monitors action being considered on the national scene. Current Social Security policies that reduce benefits for many of our annuitants continue to be reviewed in the Congress. Increasing Medicare payments loom for our members. As issues are identified and solutions proposed, a large SUAA membership will be important to maximize our ability to be heard, and gain favorable action. Your membership provides the opportunity to obtain the latest information on all of these issues and how to take action if needed. Membership also enables you to receive information about current activities on the UIUC Campus, now at no cost to you. Members only have to ask in order to receive *Inside Illinois* for life. Members also receive information about the activities of your UIUC SUAA Chapter.

How to renew your membership or become a new member:

Current Dues Deduction members do not need to take any action, as their monthly deduction continues until they inform SURS otherwise. However these members should report any change of address to SUAA as well as SURS. Annual pay members will be billed \$30.00 for their dues before the next anniversary of their renewal. If you wish to join SUAA or your membership has lapsed, you can use the forms in this newsletter. To become a dues deduct member, complete and return Section A of the form. Because of its convenience we encourage you to join under this option, but it is currently available only to SURS annuitants. If you prefer to join as an annual payment member, please complete and return section B. of the form.
